### Non-Profit Inks Deal at Bethesda Towers

*The Parenteral Drug Association Leases 20K Square Feet on East-West Hwy*



The Parenteral Drug Association (PDA) leased 20,697 square feet on the first and second floors at the Bethesda Towers - West Building in Bethesda, MD. The 184,342-square-foot office building is at 4350 East-West Highway in the Bethesda/Chevy Chase submarket.

PDA is a non-profit international association of scientists involved in the advancement of pharmaceutical and biopharmaceutical technology through education and information for industry and regulatory agencies. The firm signed a 10-year lease and will relocate from 3 Bethesda Metro Center.

Bethesda Towers - West has the largest block of contiguous office space available in the Bethesda/Chevy Chase submarket, with more than 130,000 square feet currently available.
